AIRCRAFT ENGINE PROBLEM STUDIED BY U-M STUDENTS

What kind of an aircraft engine will carry man non-stop at the fastest speed, the farthest distance and the longest time without refueling?

This is a problem being discussed in a new course given by the Department of Aeronautical Engineering at the University of Michigan.

The difficulty with our present type of high speed aircraft power plants lies in the fact that they will operate efficiently at top speed but not at slower speeds, according to John W. Luecht, assistant professor of aeronautical engineering in charge of the new course.

He pointed out that there are two good reasons why we want high speed aircraft that will operate below their top speed: (1) the need for greater flying range, and (2) the need for a plane that can fly at high altitudes and stay in the air a long time.

Another important problem involved in aircraft that fly faster and faster is the landing speed. Professor Luecht indicated. In order to have aircraft that can fly at extremely high speeds, we must have an engine that also can operate efficiently at speeds low enough to enable the pilot to land without danger, he said.

At the present time, there is no propulsion system that can successfully meet all these requirements, Professor Luecht stated. The major problem of operating high speed aircraft engines arises from the fact that reducing power output to obtain low speeds does not result in an appreciable reduction of fuel consumption, he explained.

The requirements necessary to meet the desired conditions for an aircraft power plant that can efficiently adapt to a wider range of operating speeds are being studied in the course.
