Perhaps summer is not vacation time for you.

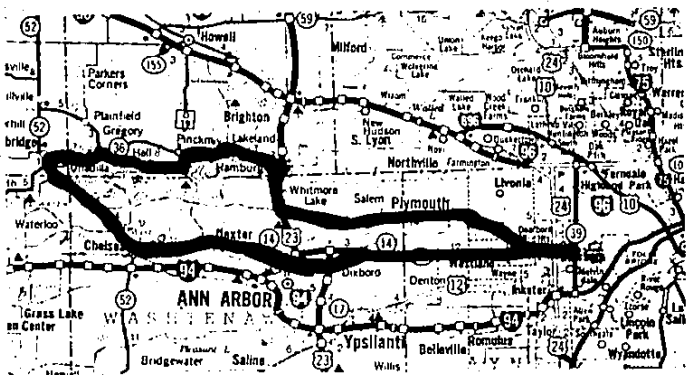

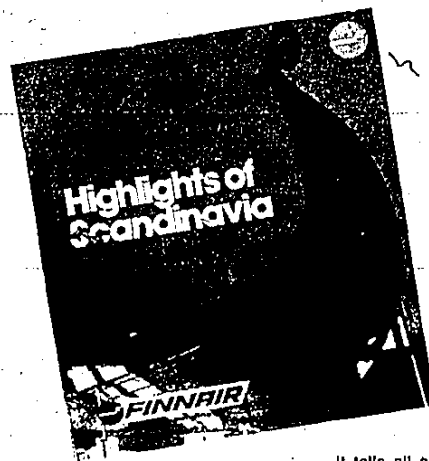
