The Wayne County Cooperative Extension Service will provide the services of "The Plant Doctor" Gerald E. Drahmel, Wayne County Horticultural Agent to answer questions of homeowners problems concerning lawns, gardens, flowers, indoor plants & insects. Homeowners might also be interested in bringing along soil samples of their lawns or gardens which can be tested for fertilizer requirements. The samples should include random samples of soil taken from various areas of the lawn or garden to a depth of six inches. The samples should be mixed together and a cupful of that material used as a sample. The cost of testing the soil is one dollar per sample and results will be mailed to the homeowner within ten days of receipt.
