Two weeks ago, Jack L. Reid of 31841 Doherty Drive and Victor Stevens of 1847 St. Francis, were looking forward to July 22, when they would head the train for their two weeks of active duty training at Camp Lejeune with Detroit's Marine Corps Organized Reserve.

Shortly after receiving the communique that cancelled the training, certain units of the Organized Reserve were alerted by Marine Corps Headquarters to go on extended active duty 10 days after receipt of their orders.

Note—MacArthur also demanded that more divisions be rushed to Japan from the United States plus heavy equipment.

FRANK GRAHAM'S FRIENDS

The post office department is investigating the anti-Negro organizations that mailed inflammatory racial propaganda from New York designed to defeat liberal senator Frank Graham of North Carolina.

Graham himself, however, doesn't want any "post-election investigation" — not even Senator Gillette's senate campaign committee, which is interested in the reported \$100,000 spent by Yankee Republicans and Dixiecrats.

What really hurts Graham deep way down is the fact that the mill workers and other poorer people whose cause he has always championed, turned their back on him on election day.

Apparently they listened to the most vicious racial propaganda since the Civil War day — tons of literature circulated by Alabama klansmen, anti-Graham propaganda mailed out under the franking privileges of Congressman Gwinn of New York, the friend of General Eisenhower; and the poisoned pen diatribes of John T. Flynn.

TRUMAN'S CABINET LUNCH

President Truman held an important lunch with his cabinet last week at which he expressed frank fears about the current attitude—especially what Korea might do to the American economy. He was particularly worried about inflation and expressed the hope that no panic-buying or hoarding of scarce materials should take place among industry or consumers. Truman has ordered the national security resources board to go all in planning it. It looks like Korea would develop into a world war.

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Add Third Pilot To Forest Fire Patrol

With the addition of Marquette pilot Robert J. Ickes, the conservation department has a three-man forest fire patrol squadron ready for quick detection and handling of fires in all three regions of the state.

Based at Lansing, Ickes will operate the first aerial detection unit ever provided by the department. In the southern third of the state, this region only has three forest fire lookout towers, located in Allegan, Montcalm and Kent Counties.

Department pilot Peter Van Val in already covers the northern lower peninsula region out of Benet Airman, John Rossi, patrols the upper peninsula region from Marquette.

All airplanes have the latest radio equipment and can contact district and regional headquarters fire towers and ground fire fighting forces. A new four-place airplane recently was purchased for use in the southern lower peninsula.
