ROTC Training Revised At MSC

Veterans may now receive reserve commissions in the U. S. Army and Air Force after completing one year of college work in the College Reserve Officers Training Corps units. The new ruling cuts in half the required time for veterans to become reserve officers through ROTC training, according to Col. Charles E. Dinsinger, commandant of the MSC ROTC unit.

HORTICULTURE MEET TO ATTRACT 150 TO M. S. C.

More than 150 horticulturists from all over the U. S. are expected to attend the annual Congress of American Horticulture at Michigan State College October 26 - 28. The conference is sponsored by the American Horticultural Council, formed in 1945 to coordinate all horticultural activities on a national scale. Professional, amateur, commercial and research horticulturists will be delegates to the congress. A new victory garden program for the nation is one of the projects to be discussed. Dr. H. B. Tukey, head of the MSC department of horticulture, is in charge of arrangements for the congress. Dr. Tukey is a member of the council's commission on research.

combat boys fruit juice and soft drinks instead.

While more profit taxes are boomed in Washington, the echo can be heard in Michigan. State Controller Robert F. Steadman says the state had a \$45,673,724 operating deficit during the fiscal year ending June 30. He says that only by new taxes can the state overcome this deficit position.

But Michiganders are saving their money. At least bank deposits in the state went up five per cent last year, making a total of more than five billion dollars as of last December.

War officials has come to Michigan's industry now. Ford and Cadillac have announced they now have war contracts — first large contracts to be let in the state.

Hand in glove with war contracts goes the labor problem. The U. S. Labor department is urging employers to consider physically handicapped workers. Penalties not handicapped World War II veterans will find a place in this new crisis.

A committee has been formed in the state to push the \$65,000,000 bond issue (to be on the November ballot) which would authorize the state to borrow money for construction of mental and TB beds. Name? Michigan Citizens Education Committee on Bond Issues for Mental and Tuberculosis Patients.

A four color map of "Historic Michigan" will be ready for distribution early in 1951, according to the state historical commission. The map has been three years in the making and goes to the printers soon.

When purchasing a new refrigerator, remember that the minimum also recommended is six cubic feet for two people, with an extra cubic foot for each additional person. However, this minimum size is easily outgrown and often it would be better to buy a larger one in the first place. The difference in initial price often pays for itself in a short time, advise Michigan State College home economists.
