Mobile unit grades apples in the orchard, boosts profits.

Field tests have shown that mobile orchard raders increase the net income from apple rops, especially where fruit is stored orchard run r marketed in unfaced crates. Michigan Stata crops, specially whire fruit is stored orchard run or marketed in unfaced crates. Michigan State College Agricultural Experiment Station, in cooperation with the U.S. Department of Agriculture, tested a grader thin weighted about 450 points and was powered by a 1-hp, saudine motor. With it, 6 or 7 pickers and a sorting crew of 4 picked and sorted 7,852 bushels of applies in 1354 hours. Results of using the mobile grader were: less handling and bruising, no unnecessary handling of undergrade fruit, increased picker output, less pagling-house space needed and longer storage life of apples.
