TO ALLOW GREATER BAG OF BEAVERS IN LOWER PENINSULA

A shortened beaver and other trapping season in the upper peninsula and a more liberal lower peninsula beaver bag limit are the only major conservation commission revisions for the 1952 spring season.

A 12-day upper peninsula trapping period, eight days shorter, will be effective March 27 - April 8, with a bag limit of six beaver and three other. Lower peninsula trapping season will have twelve days, March 30 - 31, but can take a maximum of four instead of three beaver, and three other as before.

Season opens and closes at 12:00 noon EST. In both peninsulas, the 1951 upper peninsula harvest of 12,544 beaver was a regional all-time high. The shorter 1952 season was passed in order to reduce the take and minimize the probability of a closed season in 1953. Increasing the lower peninsula limit is expected to remove surplus animals without endangering the breeding population.

Closed to trapping are refuge certain specified areas and Ardenac, Bay, Benzie, Isabella, Manistee, Mason, Midland, Muskegon and Wexford Counties.

MSC's Winter Enrollment Drops From Last Year

Michigan State College's final enrollment for the winter term reached 13,091, a five per cent drop below 1951's winter enrollment, according to Kermit Smith, assistant registrar.

The total includes 9,005 men, 4,086 women, 1,791 veterans and 291 students in agriculture and home economics short courses. The 13,091 figure is 700 less than 1951's winter term enrollment of 13,791. College officials attributed the drop to an unusually large fall term enrollment of more than 500 and a general decline in the number of students as a result of a low national birth rate in the 1930's.
