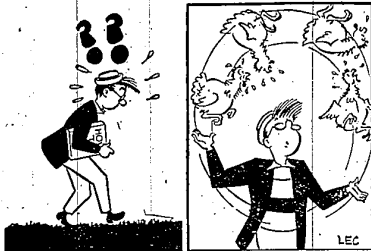

ian territory beyond the Yalu river. It has also been involved in much milder matters in the cold war.

PROPAGANDA BALLOONS

For instance, when this columnist last spring urged sending propaganda balloons behind the Iron Curtain, it was frowned on by military advisers and by some State department officials. They feared a violent reaction in Moscow.

But when the Crusade for Freedom was able to float balloons into Czechoslovakia and Poland, the freedom leaflets were mimeographed, tucked on telephone poles, mailed anonymously to Communist officials, and created such a furor that Communist newspapers, the Czech prime minister and Radio Moscow had to go into high gear to reply.

Public opinion became so riled inside Czechoslovakia that the Communists actually began looking for some way to free A.P. correspondent William Oatis in order to turn off the heat.

However, when similar balloon or propaganda projects have been urged for Hungary and other satellite countries, an official wail of disapproval has been heard from the Pentagon and by some of the more timid souls in the State department.

The reason is partly illustrated by a story told by Gen. Bedell Smith, expert head of central intelligence, who recounts a conversation between Georges Dimitroff and Stalin.

"Are you afraid of war?" Stalin was asked.

"Yes," replied Stalin, "but not as afraid as the West."

Nevertheless, there are plenty of propaganda steps that can be taken with no danger of war. Furthermore, it remains a fact that the law of the jungle remains the law of the Kremlin. And when U. S. propaganda stirs the population of Czechoslovakia or Hungary to a boiling point, the Kremlin is much more likely to act with reason.

FISH SPEARING SEASON OPEN UNTIL FEB. 29

Fish spearing season, which has produced a few big ones, continues through February 29.

Largest fish reported by conservation department field men is a 110-pound sturgeon, from Millott Lake. Record is a 216-pounder caught on the Lake Michigan shore north of Benton Harbor in 1932. The giant had a deep gash near the tail, probably the result of being wracked by a boat propeller.

Biggest of the current season is a 46-pound muskellunge reported speared in Clam Lake, Antrim county. Top muskie of record in recent years is a 62-pound one caught in Lake St. Clair in 1940.

Besides these two species, spearing through the ice is legal on inland waters. Designated designated trout waters for taking northern pike, whitefish, lake trout, carp, suckers, mullet, sheepshead, redhorse, smelt, cisco, pike, catfish, bullheads, dogfish and garpike.

Winter Kill Of Fish In Lakes Not Likely

Early season threat of winter kill of fish has subsided, the conservation department reports.

Tests, following January thaws, on several shallow-type southern lakes where winter suffocation is most likely to occur if anywhere, show three to four parts oxygen per million parts water. Three is considered safe for all warm water fish.

There has been no threat to northern lakes because of generally less snow sealing out the sun on these waters. Ice has not been as thick as usual, in fact there has been no ice on Grand Traverse bay so far this year.

More than 50 per cent of Michigan's tourist accommodations now remain open throughout the year, according to the State Tourist Council. Only a few years ago most of them discontinued operations soon after Labor Day.
