FUNERAL SERVICES TO BE HELD FRIDAY FOR REV. ROBERT BROWN

Funeral services will be held Friday, March 21, at 10:00 from the Spencer J. Heeley Funeral Home for Robert Brown, 29921 Ardmore, who passed away March 18 at the Highland Park General Hospital after a brief illness.

Mr. Brown is the father of Wendell Brown, member of the Board of Education of the Farmington Township School District.

Robert Brown was born July 28, 1863, on a farm in Ontario, Canada. He was the eldest of ten children. In the mid eighties, Mr. Brown came to Huron County, Michigan, where he taught school. He became a naturalized citizen of the United States in 1886. During that period he met Miss Jabe Anderson of Cassville and they were united in marriage January 28, 1891. Mrs. Brown passed away in February, 1932.

During the nineties, Mr. Brown studied the ministry at McCormick Theological Seminary in Chicago, from which institution he graduated. He entered the ministry of the Presbyterian Church with his first pastorate at Michigan, Minnesota. He served approximately five years as pastor in Grand Haven before he took time out to complete his law studies.

Rev. William Lovejoy of Franklin will officiate at the service and Rev. Carl Schuler of Farmington will read Scriptures. Burial will be at Cassville Cemetery, Cassville, Michigan, where a brief committal service will be held at 4:00 p.m. Friday.
