Cross Michigan Unit. If you desire transportation call Mrs. Weber at Farmington 1669. There will also be a nursery set up in the Town Hall for handling children while their parents are at the bank.

Farmington residents have two important reasons for contributing blood at the local bank. One is for the servicemen in Korea who are running out of blood and the other is the new "credit bank" which is being set up to accommodate Farmington residents who may need blood. Persons may donate blood when they visit the blood bank, whether they want their blood to be credited to Farmington. The total amount of "credit" is then available to local residents who may require it without charge. They are asked whenever possible to replace the blood. Under the plan blood will be made available immediately for Korea and a "credit" will be established for individual emergencies.

Persons giving blood must be between the ages of 18 and 50 and must have no history of heart disease or jaundice. Those from 18 to 21 must have written permission from their parents or guardians before they can contribute, unless they are members of the Armed Forces.

Two Farmington Soldiers Awarded Combat Badge

Two Farmington men serving with the 45th Infantry Division in Korea have been awarded the Combat Infantryman Badge, symbol of the front line fighting man. Army authorities in Korea report: "The two are Sergeant First Class Robert L. McLean, son of Mr. and Mrs. P. L. McLean of 22521 Averhill Street, and Corporal David L. Hopkins, son of Mr. and Mrs. R. K. Hopkins of 23282 Lakeway.

The badge consists of a miniature replica of a Revolutionary War flintlock rifle mounted on a blue background and superimposed on a wreath.

Sgt. McLean is a squad leader in the 27th Infantry Regiment's "C" Company. Corporal Hopkins is a machine gunner in Company "B" of the 27th Infantry Regiment. Both entered the Army in October 1949 and joined the 45th Division in November, 1950.

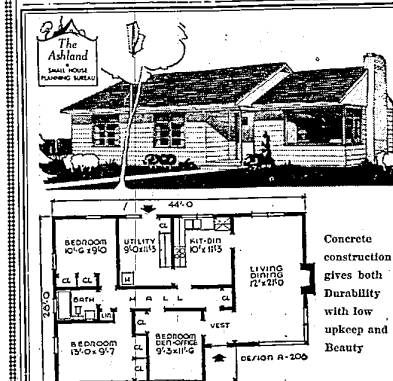
