Now hopes for a balanced budget in the proposed 2 per cent industrial processing tax estimate to raise \$20 million. That faces rough sledding. In the House this week, it goes to the Senate next week if approved.

Position of legislators is not enviable," he opines. "Folks back home don't want taxes; serious curtailment of (public) services would bring vigorous protests.

So when the legislature adjourns next week (if it can really pass all pending legislation to a final vote by that time), lawmakers will be glad to get away from the whole mess for a while. Michigan's income is its taxes. Raising three brings protest from the taxpayers. That isn't bad enough; legislative attempts to raise the intake have run into veto by Governor Whitcomb.

They passed a Used Car Transfer tax that was to raise \$12 million. This the Governor vetoed," says Mr. Brake.

William's vetoed a bill replacing the sales tax on liquor (which has to be split up with schools and local governments) with a 3 per cent Handling Tax (which the State can keep property). He also vetoed an attempt to keep \$1.5 million in Liquor License Fees in the State treasury instead of passing it down to local governments.

They passed the Corporation Franchise Tax from 3 1/2 to 4 mills. This is supposed to yield an additional \$10 million." Increases and revisions in intangibles taxes should add \$5.5 million. Another million is to come from changes in Insurance Company and National Bank taxes.

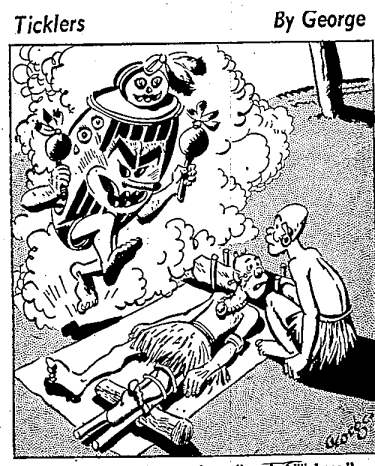
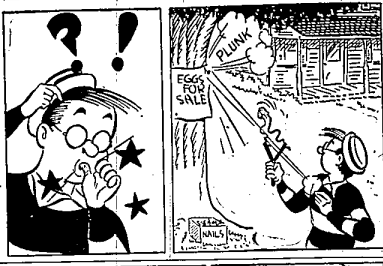
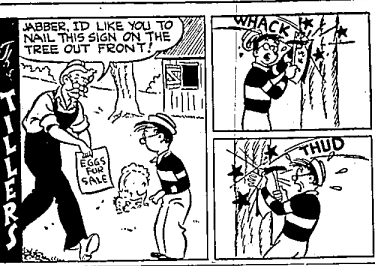
