











June Bounty Payments By George

Bounty payments in-June dropped more than 50 per cent from May, with \$9,490 being paid to hunters and trappers for foxes, coyotes and -bobcats. No wolves were bountied in June.

Michigan paid \$8,340 for 1,658 coxes, \$1,050 for 50 coyotes, and \$100 for 20 bobcats.

All these totals represented drops from May totals, when \$20,-100 was paid out for 3,706 foxes, 126 coyotes and 33 bobcats.
