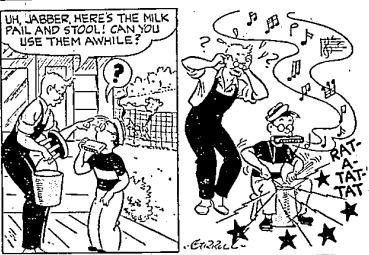

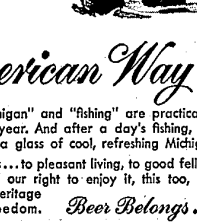

The greatest single concentration of American air power ever to appear in an air show is promised Michigan for Labor Day week end when the Fifth Annual International Aviation Exposition opens at Detroit - Wayne Major Airport, August 30, 31 and September 1, according to Major General Harry A. Johnson, Commanding General of Headquarters, Tenth Air Force at Selfridge Field.
General Johnson has been assigned by the Department of Defense as Senior Officer for military participation in the Air Exposition.
