## City Council

A petition was filed by a group of residents on Lilac and Violet Street north of Shawwassee registering objections to the vacating of alleys in the Floral Park section. The Monday evening meeting was the date set for public hearing on the question. As a result of the session, the Council decided to delay action on the vacation of the alleys until a further survey of the area can be made.

A representative of the Bell Telephone Company appeared before the Council to discuss the location and color of the public phone booth on Grand River near the Town Hall park. The Council had previously objected to both the location and the color. After a brief discussion, City Manager James Tennant was directed to get together with the representatives and try to work out a new plan.

The Council moved to transfer \$5,000 from four different funds to the street fund. The money will be drawn from the fire department fund, which is a surplus, the contingent fund, new sewers fund and new water mains fund.

Mildred Grace was appointed by the Council to the Library Board to fill a vacancy created by the resignation of Anna Brown. Dr. Joseph Gadavay and Dr. Theodore Ling were appointed as city health officers.

A motion was passed to charge only 50¢ of the present building fee to churches, schools, hospitals and other legally recognized non-profit organizations. The motion also provided that the new ruling be made retroactive to July 1, 1952. Thus Our Lady of Sorrows Parish and the Farmington Township School District will receive a refund on the building fees paid for new construction in the city.


## CELEBRATE BIRTHDAY
