TAKE ADVANTAGE OF GOOD PEACH CROP, SAYS EXPERT

Michigan's peach crop is a good one and homemakers should take advantage of the situation, according to Roberts Hersey, Michigan State College foods and nutrition extension specialist. Miss Hersey gives some tips on peach use.

For easy peeling, she suggests dipping well-washed peaches in boiling water for just one minute — no more — and then immediately into cold water. If you are canning peaches you will be interested in knowing that it is important to wash them before dipping into the hot water to wash off some of the spoilage bacteria.

Miss Hersey says that after the boiling water dip it is easy to slip off the skins. If you drop the peeled halves in a solution of two tablespoons of salt and two of vinegar to a gallon of water, you can keep them from turning black.

How about serving broiled peaches around the edge of the platter with your next roast, whether it's beef, pork or canned chicken? Place peaches in a shallow pan, pour just a little honey or brown sugar and a wee bit of fat over them and slide the pan under the broiler until they are done.

Here is another idea suggested by the home economist. Put a generous spoonful of cottage cheese between two halves of peach and drizzle with honey dressing. The honey dressing is made by mixing equal parts of strained honey and lemon juice. The lemon juice keeps the peaches from discoloring and lends a pleasant flavor at the same time. Or set sliced peaches and blueberries in lemon gelatin made with part ginger ale. That will add zip to the peach flavor, says Miss Hersey.

CONSERVATION DEPT. BUILDS PLANTER TO SET 8,000 TREES DAILY

A rugged "planter" tree planting device by the conservation department when commercial models proved too light for use under certain conditions found in Michigan, is nearing completion of tests and has lasted two years.

Designed by T. E. Daw, assistant chief of the department's forestry division, the husky machine is operated by two men and can plant 8 to 10,000 trees in a day under normal conditions. The first test model was constructed at Roscomore forest experiment station in 1949 and was used during the 1951 fall planting season. In the winter of 1950-51, six more machines were built, with improvements designed during the first test period. These were used during the 1951 fall planting season, where weaknesses were noted for correction.

Control Removal Won't Change Gas Situation

Removal of Petroleum Administration for Defense restrictions on use of natural gas in this area, "will do little to change the local situation, according to District Manager George L. Mayhew. "Connecting of additional gas space-heating customers," Mayhew said, "is not the answer for the present time on a restricted basis."

"Some months ago, the company found itself in a position to connect 15,000 additional space-heating customers," said Mayhew. "We asked and obtained the approval of both the Michigan Public Service Commission and the Petroleum Administration for Defense. We are now well along with the connecting of those 15,000 customers."

"The removal of PAD restrictions is a welcome development," said Mayhew. "If the gas situation in Michigan Public Service Commission, which is thoroughly familiar with local conditions, was the proper agency to exercise control in Michigan."

"Consumers is now free to supply natural gas to large industrial customers without asking the approval of any regulatory body. It formerly was necessary to obtain a certificate from PAD. Certificates were granted to all industrial cases submitted."

Potato Cost Increased By Small Packaging

Giving Mrs. Housewife what she wants sometimes proves more expensive. That's particularly true for the potato grower, according to a report from the Michigan Agricultural Experiment Station. The size most desired by the home-maker — costs the packer 72 cent a hundred pounds. Pack-sized packages (15 pounds) cost a total of 55 cents a hundred pounds. The fifty pound paper bag is the least expensive for the packer.
