Arguments against — It would give representation to area or geographical units in the Senate, leading to a possible stalemate in legislation. The House would not be on a straight population basis, since, in effect, the moiety clause would be retained. The Senate would not be based on a true apportionment, but rather would be a compromise since some recognition has been given to population.

The total forest land area of Michigan is about 19 million acres. Of this total, more than 17 million acres of timber are slated for commercial use. Stands of aspen-birch total six million acres, northern hardwoods cover five million acres, and swamp stands, spruce-fir and pine, make up most of the remainder.
