#### DETROIT DOCTOR ADVISES CARE TO AVOID COLDS

Colds are provilent as is cus-tomary this time lot year, Dr. Jo-seph 6. Molner, commissioner of health, remarks. This is one of the three peak periods of the year when colds and respiratory infections usually occur. The oth-er two are early fall and again in March or April.

It is well worth your while to take all possible precautions to avoid colds and to lake care of yourself if you get one, Dr. Moiner advises. - 1. Whenever possible, stay away
- 70m people who have colds.
  2. Get plenty of rest.
  3. Wash your hands before eating or handling food.
  4. Eat meals that are well bal-
- anced.
  5. Avoid over-fatigue.
  6. Get enough sleep to wake re-freshed.


