

College Credit Can Be Earned

High school students can earn four semester hours of college credit through a summer science institute on the Orchard Ridge campus of Oakland Community College in Farmington.

Interested science students will have an opportunity to explore their physical world and conduct guided experiments, according to Dr. Charles Wyron, chairman of physical science department.

The institute is open to juniors and seniors who have successfully completed algebra and have an interest in science. Registration is limited to the first 30 applicants who contact the department. Tuition is \$40 plus approximately \$5 for textbooks.

The six-week program begins June 25 and will meet every Monday and Wednesday from 10 a.m. until 5 p.m. and Fridays from 10 a.m. until 3 p.m.

Blue Shield Elects Kramer

SOUTHFIELD Former State Rep. Albert A. Kramer has been reelected to the executive managing board of directors of Michigan Blue Shield for the third straight year.

Kramer was elected to the board of directors at the annual meeting of the Blue Shield Board of Control. He was a six-year veteran of the Michigan House and was chairman of the House Insurance Committee.

His appointment was made by the Michigan Insurance Commissioner. The Insurance Department is an agency within the state executive branch.

Presently, the company has more than five million policyholders and has the largest Blue Shield plan in the U.S.

Other public members elected, besides Kramer, include: George Gullen, president of Wayne State University; Donald Young, vice-president of communications, Surrongis Corp.; Sanders Goodstein, president of General Foundry & Manufacturing Co. in Flint; and Sylvester Angel, director of the Model Cities program in Detroit.

Kramer was recently elected a member of the Representative Assembly of the State Bar Assn. of Michigan. The assembly is the highest policy-making body of the State Bar, and creates policy for about 13,000 licensed attorneys in Michigan.
