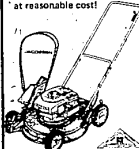


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Wayne Women Honor 7 Grads

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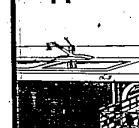
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Y Schedules Course For Junior Models

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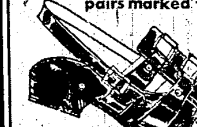
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
