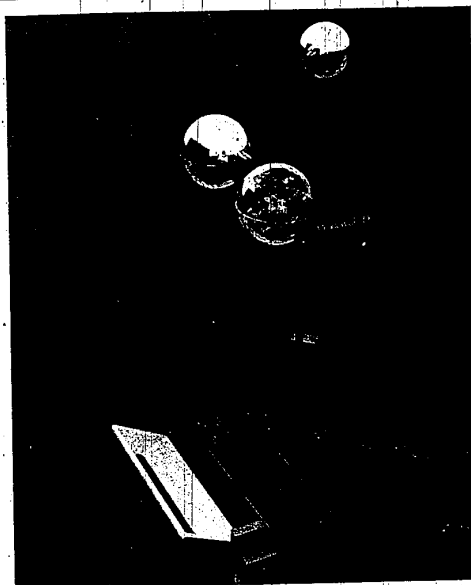

A Lamp Pole 'System' Reduces Street Clutter

A Farmington man involved in Ford Motor Co.'s design of a multi-purpose street pole system has accepted a national award from the American Iron and Steel Institute.

The director of Ford's industrial design office, John Najjar of 29729 Highmeadow Dr., accepted the 1973 "design in steel" award for himself and colleagues Stephen M. Sherer, Jon F. Morgan and Richard F. Snow.

"The pole system reduces space requirements and minimizes visual clutter in parks and along streets," Najjar explained.

Besides holding street lights, the system can hold a planter box, litter container, mailbox, street identification signs, drinking fountain, bench, telephone stand and parking control signs.

The system is installed in the Fairlane East residential area and Parklane Towers area of Dearborn. It is manufactured by Spaulding Co. of Cincinnati.

It was judged "best design category, the competition in the environmental enhancement and control equipment category." With 14 categories, engineers and artists.

Ontario Monitors Walleye Catches In Border Lakes

Southeastern Michigan fishermen are being used to cooperate in an Ontario study on walleyes by reporting their catches of the marked fish from Lake St. Clair, lower Lake Huron and western Lake Erie.

The special project is part of a cooperative program between the Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources and the

Michigan Department of Natural Resources. It is designed to trace walleye movements in those neighboring waters.

Sport catch reports on walleyes tagged by the Ontario department may be made to local DNR fisheries men in Michigan. They also may be forwarded directly to: Lake Erie Fisheries Research Station, RR 1, Wheatley, Ontario NOP 2P0.

Each report should be accompanied by the Walleye's Ontario tag. It should give the name and address of the fisherman, the date and location of his walleye catch, the sex of the fish and its total length (from tip of snout to tip of tail).
