- WE WILL RECEIVE MORE THAN \$900,000 ANNUALLY IN GAS AND WEIGHT TAXES FOR OUR ROADS as an incorporated city. This amount is now paid to the county which will spend only \$202,000 this year in Farmington Township.
- THE CHARTER ESTABLISHES A CEILING ON TAXES for financing of city government. Tax rates can be increased only if the voters approve.
- A CITY GOVERNMENT CAN REGULATE ITS OWN TRAFFIC through use of stop lights and signs. Our traffic is now controlled by county government.
- SOUND PLANNING FOR LAND USE WITHIN THE COMMUNITY CAN PROCEED WITH ASSURANCE that annexation of substantial areas will not make it worthless.
- THE CHARTER PRESERVES THE CHARACTER OF OUR COMMUNITY by embracing the Zoning Ordinances of the Township and the two Villages.
- THE CHARTER'S CODE OF ETHICS SETS A PRECEDENT IN THE STATE OF MICHIGAN with its requirements for conduct and responsibility for the council members and officials:
