## Higher Wages Of Hospital Personnel Sgt. Howard Packard Returns From Korea

The survey found that between 1947 and 1951 he average cost ner patient-day fose from \$15.33 to \$22.88, an increase of \$87.55. Wages and salaries for hospital personnel accounted for \$5.15 of that increase, \$8.2 per cent.

The report said that about 73 per cent of that increase in payrell cost was for higher salary rates and the remaining 27 per cent for additional employees. However, the survey pointed out that despite these wage increases, average salaries for bospital employees in 1951 were still considerably below the average for comparable jobs in abnumanufacturing industry.
