bond covering 100% of the cost. The bond would cover 36 months of operation. If for any reason the plant does not meet requirements of operation in that period of time the bond must be forfeited. Therefore, there is no risk as far as the taxpayers' money is concerned, officials pointed out.

However, before construction can begin, the city must appear in Court as defendant against the state on charges of failing to comply with the plans and specifications, deadline set by the Water Resources Commission.
