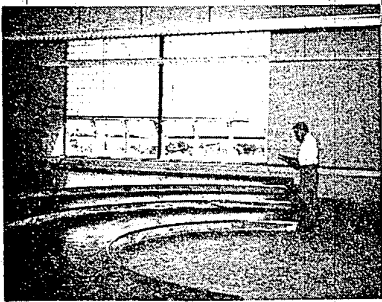

School Board To Cooperate With City In Construction Of Shiawassee Drain

Cost of New Sewer On Shiawassee Street To Be Shared Jointly By District And City

The Farmington Township School Board approved a motion at its regular meeting Monday night to cooperate with the city in construction of a 30-inch cover drain the along Shiawassee in front of the new high school property. This construction would eliminate the open drainage ditch which now cuts across the school property at the west of the new building. Cost of the project will be met jointly by the city and the school district.

The Board agreed to seek legal opinion from the school attorney as to whether it could dedicate part of the school property for an extension of Prospect Street to the Shiawassee. The opinion as rendered by the attorney will be read at a special meeting of the Board on July 27.

Earlier in the evening a representative of the J. M. Cook Construction Co., which is developing a tract of land lying north and west of the new high school site, appeared to explain his company's proposal that the school district acquire a strip of land 40 feet by 120 feet on the northwest corner of the school property for \$3,400. It was explained that such a purchase was considered in line with the extension of Prospect Street. The Board at its meeting on Monday night took no action on the proposal, which it viewed favorably by the Board, would require a vote by qualified electors in the district before action could be taken.

James Landrent, Oakland County Civil Defense director, who attended the meeting, pointed out that arm bands could be secured through the county organization at a cost of \$1.00 per band. He added that the arm bands would be assorted for the various types of personnel.
