While Clarencene the 1953 figure is 1,126 children compared to 915 last year. In the five to 15 year old group Farmington shows 3,590 compared to 3,300 last year. Clarencene reports 2,336 for 1953 compared to 2,015 last year.

What does all the new building and all the statistics mean? Simply that Farmington and Clarencene have a new record in building classroom facilities and further that more records will have to be set in the near future.
