Outdoor Art Festival To Feature Work By Spanish-Born Artist

Among the many famous artists entering the Kirk-in-the-Hills Outdoor Art Festival to be held from 1:00 to 5:00 p.m. on August 27, 28 and 29, will be Joan Junyer. Mr. Junyer, a widely known innovator, has created quite a stir among art circles. Time Magazine, July 9, 1951, says, "Joan Junyer is a painter who paints no pictures, a sculptor who carves no stone. He molds abstract shapes of wood and plaster, paints them with faveling, rainbow strokes of cool color, ornaments them with bold patterns, simplified human figures and shadow-casting bumps and contours. Results: a new kind of sculpture. So he turned to sculpture - paintings, which are made to fit odd corners as well as flat walls, can be seen from different angles, in changing lights, with an almost unlimited variety of effects. Each angle and light shows a different facet of Junyer's work."

Artists from the 48 states, Holland, France and Japan, many of a more conventional school, have entered their works in the Kirk's 1952 Art Festival. Prizes will be awarded in four classes: Watercolor, Sculpture, Graphic Arts and Oil Painting.

All works exhibited on the Kirk's beautiful grounds, located on West Long Lake Road, will be offered for sale. Prices range from \$10 to \$15 for one sculpture. The majority are in the \$25 to \$300 price range. The show is open to the public.
