The Farmington Optimist Club became the first civic organization in 1973 to become a "century member" of the Clinton Valley Council, Boy Scouts of America.

A check for \$100 was presented to George Brand, local scout executive, by Gary Cook at a meeting at Treasurer House.

The money "represents helping more boys in the Farmington area to receive the program, camping experience and trained adult leadership of scouting," Cook said.

The council has begun private solicitation because of declining grants from the United Fund.

Five years ago, for example, UF provided 94 percent of the council's budget. This year it will meet only 10.6 percent of the \$308,500 needed.

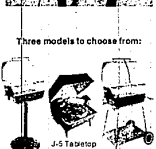
