RED CROSS STUDY OF EQUIPMENT, HELP TO BE MADE JUNE 9

Executive secretaries of five Michigan American Red Cross chapters will meet in Oakland County June 9 to learn the names of trained volunteers and equipment each can get from the others if disaster — like last spring's tornadoes — strikes this area.

John Moorer, the Red Cross public relations chairman, called the June 9 meeting at the local Red Cross chapter house at 118 Franklin Boulevard, Pontiac, after meeting with executive secretaries of a dozen big Michigan Red Cross chapters this week. The June meeting will include chiefs of Oakland, Macomb, Washtenaw, Genesee and Wayne County Red Cross chapters.

The group decided last week that as soon as a disaster strikes one area, all executive secretaries of adjoining chapters will rush to the scene as soon as they find it out. These people, trained and experienced, can help local volunteers cope with the hopeless, hurt and sick until national Red Cross disaster workers arrive.

Mrs. Mildred E. Bennett, executive secretary of Oakland County Chapter, said each Red Cross chapter will make up a list of the trained volunteers and equipment — all the way from flashlights to radio trucks — each chapter has. Copies of the list will be given to nearby chapters and filed in state Red Cross offices in Lansing.
