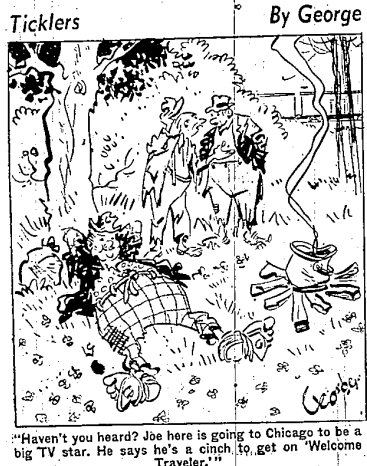
Miss Grosop graduated from Kingswood School, Grand River, June 12. Prior to attending Cranbrook for her senior year, she was a student at Farmington High.

Independents are much alike to consumers in time and money saving devices.

In the field of food retailing, Michigan chains and independents find much in common.

As early as 1910 and the inspiration of the Michigan Press Association, the Michigan Retail Food Dealers Association and the Michigan Chain Stores Bureau established high marks in harmonious trade relations.

The three groups formed the Michigan Food Council. An immediate achievement was the successful sponsorship of "Michigan Days" to promote sale of Michigan-grown food. The campaign made national history.

Times have changed radically in the relations of chains and independents here in the past 40 years. It is no hickering any longer exists. Neither seeks punitive action against the other.

Statistics show the small operator is more than holding his own. That is one of the reasons the Michigan legislature will take a new look at chain store taxes in 1955.

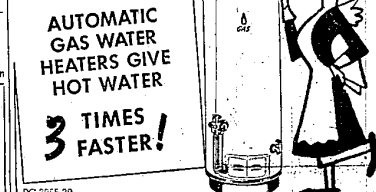
