

Super Salad, Burgers Make Memorial Day Memorable

Decoration Day, that first long holiday weekend, officially opens the picnic season.

The true outdoorsmen have been cooking out almost year round, but for the traditionalist it's time now for the first picnic.

Although the fine art of barbecuing has achieved the gourmet stage, it seems that to most of us an honest-to-goodness picnic means hotdogs, hamburgers, potato salad and baked beans.

Potato salad can be a mushy, tasteless disaster. This can be the result of overcooking the potatoes. Do let them chill before dicing. Add green onions, chopping leaves and all. Be generous with the hard cooked eggs. I like to separate the yolks and whites. Chop the whites with the potatoes and add the mayonnaise to the mashed yolks.

Four enough Italian dressing over the chopped potatoes, onions and egg whites to pretty well coat each piece. Chill; then add the mayonnaise just before serving.

As a meat stretcher, try adding finely ground pretzels to the ground meat.

And you may want to try some new toppings for the broiled burgers.

TOMATO TOPPING
Combine 1/4 cup catsup, one tablespoon prepared mustard and one teaspoon Worcestershire sauce.

BUBBLY BLUE TOPPING
Combine 1/2 cup dairy sour cream and 1/4 cup crumbled blue cheese.

CORNY TOPPING
One 13-ounce jar of corn relish is sufficient for eight beefburgers.

PRETZEL CRUSTED BURGERS
2 lbs. ground lean beef
2 eggs
1 small onion, chopped
1/2 t. pepper
1/4 t. garlic powder
1 can tomato sauce
2 c. finely crushed pretzels

Combine meat, eggs, onion, pepper, salt, garlic powder, tomato sauce and one cup pretzel crumbs. Mix well and shape into patties about 3/4-inch thick. Roll patties in remaining crumbs. Grill six inches above grey coals until brown and crust on both sides. Serve on toasted hamburger buns with desired condiments.

PATIO SALAD
1 pkg. lemon-flavored gelatin
1 c. boiling water
1 1/4 t. grated lemon rind
2 T. lemon juice
Dash of salt
2 c. applesauce
1 c. diced celery
1/4 c. diced pimiento

Dissolve gelatin in boiling water; stir in lemon rind, lemon juice and salt. Add applesauce, celery and pimiento; mix well. Pour into five-cup ring mold which has been rinsed with cold water. Chill until set. Unmold just before serving and fill center with cottage cheese.
