The following policy on equal opportunity was adopted at the National Association of Real Estate Board (NAREB) Convention in November,

We subscribe to the policy that equal opportunity in the acquisition of housing can best be achieved through leadership, observance of law, education, and the mutual cooperation of the real estate industry and the public and through a free and open housing market. We, therefore, have formulated a Code for Equal Opportunity for adoption by local boards of Realtors whose members pledge to offer equal service to all clients or prospective clients without regard to race, color, religion, or national origin, and to refrain from any activity which has the purpose of inducing panic selling.

We note that under the pretext of discouraging blockbusting or panic selling certain anti-solicitation\_and anti-sign ordinances have been adopted which have as their true purpose the inhibition of a free and open housing market. We, therefore, oppose such statutes, ordinances, regulations, or rules which would have the effect of denying any person the right to sell, purchase, manage, or rent, or any real estate licensee the right to solicit the sale, purchase, management, or rental of real property.

The Michigan Real Estate Association has also adopted this code and urges all local Boards of Realtors to make it part of their provisions with the same full force and effect as the Code of Ethics, By-Laws, and Rules and Regulations.

Fallure to comply can lead to appropriate disciplinary action including fine, suspension, or expulsion. The new code is additional to the previous statement on equal opportunity in housing adopted May 28, 1969 and given wide distribution since that time.
