

# Vitamin A Deficiency May Cause Blood Spots in Eggs

Poultrymen who are having blood spots on their eggs may be feeding too much corn during the summer. Michigan State College poultry specialists indicate that during the summer, the hens need a mash that is well fortified with vitamin A. Green feed is high in vitamin A but it makes the egg yolk dark.

Another reason for the blood spots may be feeding too much corn during the summer. Research results haven't proved this, however.

# WOMEN BUY MOST MEN'S SHIRTS, USE GUESSING METHOD

Salemen in clothing stores frankly admit that the majority of men's shirts are bought by women. They reveal that women are apt to use a "guess" method in deciding the size. Women ask: "What size do you wear - my husband looks about your height."


But it's not as simple as that. Know the neckband size and the sleeve length. . . look for these measurements on the shirt label. They are a safer guide than the torso - small, medium, and large. Most sleeve lengths range from 32 to 36 inches. A few manufacturers have a range of 31 to 37 inches. To determine the correct length - measure from the bone at the back of the neck to the wrist bone, with the arms held straight at the sides.

Neck sizes in most men's shirts range from 14 to 18 inches. To be sure of getting the right size, measure the inside of the neck band from the center of the button to the far end of the buttonhole.

Shoulder length is important. It suggests Florence Rann, clothing specialist at Michigan State College. However, if the neckband size and the sleeve length are correct, the shoulder will usually be right.
