Fire Damages Dr. Hanna Residence

Upon arrival, the Parmington volunteer firemen took little time in bringing the roof and attic flames under centrel without causing damage to the rest of the house. In statements later, Dr. and Mrs. Hanna praised the firemen highly for their fast action in halting the blaze and keeping water damage to a malimum.
