

The conservation commission is expected to take action at its August 12 - 13 meeting on proposed changes in trout regulations, the conservation department reports. At its July meeting, the seven-member commission received a summary of action taken since the proposed changes were first pre-sented to the angling public in December, 1953.

Since that date, three public hearings have been held and views and opinions of interested sports, which was presented together with the recommendations for changes suggested in light of the public hearings. The proposed changes are:

1. 


