SUGGESTIONS FOR
HOMEMAKERS ON
BROILER CARE

Home economists at Michigan
State College offer homemakers
these suggestions for cleaning and
caring for broilers:

Grease the rack of the broiler
with salad oil or shortening be-
fore using it and it will be easier
to clean.

After broiling, pour off all the
drippings as soon as you have re-
moved the food. Use paper towels
to wipe off both the pan and the
chicken.

Then fill the pan immediately
with very hot water, and add a
scoop powder or detergent. Let
the pan and rack stand until you
are ready to wash them. Wash
fresh, hot suds, you'll find them
easy to clean.

If you drop a bone to save the
drippings, add enough trisodium
phosphate to form a soap suds.
Then it can be flushed down the
drain.

If food sticks, you can use steel
wool pads containing soap if your
broiler is aluminum or stainless
steel. Enamel broilers, however,
require more gentle treatment.

The MSU home economists sug-
gest that you may want to remove
the broiler when using your oven.
This will prevent any possibility
of cracking of the enamel or war-
ping of the metal pan.

VISITORS TO NORTH
WARNED TO BE
CAUTIOUS OF BEAR

Visitors to northern Michigan
this year are again urged to be
cautious of bears when traveling
in the out-of-doors.

The MSU home economists sug-
gest that you may want to remove

Field workers report that a
day July in the northern areas
has cut into the expected berry
crops and sent bears looking else-
where for food.

Bears found near city garbage
bins, restaurants and other
similar places should be cautiously
avoided. Photographs should
be made from a distance.

The bear is one of the most
burly and treacherous of animals.
His moods are variable and un-
predictable. He should be left strict-
ly alone.
