


Readied Weapons In Car In Game Areas Illegal

It is illegal to travel in a vehicle through a hunting or game area with a strung bow or a rifle or shotgun not taken down. Twenty-four persons were reported last week to have paid heavy fines and costs for violation of this conservation law. Of the total, 97 paid fines for game law violations, 12 for fish law infractions, and three for camping in state forests without permits.

Waterford Drops Falcon Gridders

Displaying a brilliant running and passing attack, the Waterford Skippers whitewashed the Farmington Falcons on Friday last Friday afternoon, 37 - 0. Three of the Skippers' six tallies were scored on long passes. Receivers skirted downfield nimbly and worked behind Falcon defenders on each occasion. Waterford's passer, with a good defensive line in front of him, had little trouble in hitting his targets and they were off for TD's. The Skippers scored two other touchdowns on long runs around the Falcon ends, one a 70-yard punt. They scored their sixth and final touchdown by blocking a Falcon pass in mid-air and then catching it themselves and scampering off to pay dirt. Farmington's defensive showed only spotty signs of offering any resistance to the Skippers' offensive attack throughout the game. Farmington still has not shown any key blocking necessary and was halted in its tracks. Farmington mastered only one sustained drive in the contest late in the second period. A ninety-yard run and passes by Rice to Don Donoghue of 20 yards and 9 yards put the call in scoring position but too late. The half-time gun ended the drive. This Friday afternoon the Falcons will take on Wallis Lake home, still not having tasted the pleasure of a victory.

Shaking off the injury jinx, rugged 195 pound Jim Bates, son of Mr. and Mrs. V. O. Bates of 34114 Thomas Street, 6, started the regular action with the University of Michigan Wolverines. His stellar efforts as defensive line backer and offensive center last Saturday against Minnesota helped the U. of M. eleven chalk up a brilliant 34 - 0 victory. This is the first year in his three years on the Wolverine Varsity that Bates has had a real chance to show his stuff. Slated as top double duty prospect at end in his sophomore year, he was put out of action with injuries after seeing only 20 minutes of play in the first three games. Shifted to center last Friday, he was regarded as top center prospect because of his defensive ability. Again he was shelved with injuries, this time before the season actually began. Early this season pneumonia set him back but at least did not hold him out altogether for the season. Bates, 21, is a senior this year and is majoring in education. He will be remembered locally for his brilliant gridiron performances with the Farmington Falcons prior to entering college.
