So many times the parent will say, "Put the spoon in your other paddy or other hand." It is just as easy to say, "You are eating with your left hand, hold the spoon dy or other hand." It is just as easy to-say, "You are eating with your left hand, hold the spoon with your right hand." With repetition, the child gradually learns which is left and which is right. If the child knows left from right, it is much easler for his teacher to explain left to right movement across the page than if he lacks this knowledge.

This is not to suggest that it is good to change hand preference, but rather to show how we can use situations in the home to prepare a child for activities in the school.






