What's Good For Lawn Is Good For Trees

Trees grow better on a untended ground. Where tree trients, stepped up fertiliwell-fertilized, lawn than on roots and grass compete for thion may be needed.

Most tree roots extend well syond the canopy spread, and fertilization beyond the simplene still benefits the tree.

DUTCH ELM DISEASE
Benlate has been registered as an aid in the control of Dutch elm disease.
According to Gurdon K. Dennis, district extension horticultural agent, it is not a cure-all. Methoxychlor sprays and sanitation should be continued when adding theuse of Benlate to control programs.
Compline Benlate with Methoxychlor spring sprays before beetles begin to feed.
There is a 60 per cent chance of curing trees with Dutch elm disease if they show five per cent or less infection in the crown. There is less than 50 per cent chance of curie if the crown shows five to 10 per cent infection. cent infedtion.

There is no chance of cure if root graft or more

than 10 per cent crown infection.

RATE OF APPLICATION: Eight pounds op per cent w.p. per 100 gallons of water as a foliari spray, two to three gallons of formulation per tree. Injection method: two pounds per 100 gallons; injections at two-inch intervals and left in place; 24 to 48 hours.





Shade trees are often fed by filling holes bored into the soil with fertilizer. It is doubtful that benefits to the tree are any greater for this method than by spreading fertilizer over the lawn beneath the tree.

It is certainly more economical to spread a fertilizer with a lawn spreader than it is to dig fertilization holes. Incidentally, the latter stimulate tuths of grass growth at the expense of lawn uniformity.

mity. Slow-release lawn fertilizers have much to recommend them for trees as well as grass, and should cause less lawn pocking when fertilizer is buried.
