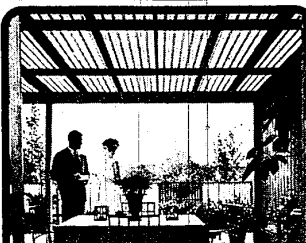

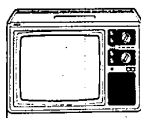

C'ville Grads To Hear Scholes

Dr. Gene W. Scholes, Clarenceville High School graduate and former administrative assistant and teacher in the district, will deliver the high school commencement address at Clarenceville Thursday, June 14, at 8 p.m. in the L.E. Schmidt Auditorium.

Currently assistant to the president and associate professor of education at Morehead State University in Kentucky, Dr. Scholes will speak on "The Age of Opportunity."

The speaker earned a BS from Eastern Michigan Uni-

versity, an MS also from EMU and a PhD from the University of Michigan with a major in general educational administration.

In addition to his Clarenceville positions, Dr. Scholes

also coached varsity football and basketball and was assistant director for a Livonia youth summer program.

At Morehead, Dr. Scholes' duties as assistant to the president are involved

primarily with providing evaluative data and analyses for institutional surveillance and assisting in reorganizational efforts with the administrative structure of the University.

Equipment Items On C'ville Agenda

Supt. David McDowell will present several proposals for curriculum and equipment improvements when the Clarenceville Board of Education meets Thursday at 7:30 p.m. in the board of education.

On the superintendent's portion of the agenda are a proposal for a drivers' training range (classes now use city streets), a proposal for a high school language lab, and a request from an industrial arts teacher for electronics classroom equipment.

Business Manager Edward Salisz will report and make a recommendation on an incinerator pollution control problem and report on the

status of emergency repairs to the board office.

He will also report on the gasoline shortage and how it may affect the school district.

The board will receive reports from its own attorney, John Shantz, and from Robert Saxton, attorney for a coalition of school districts, on how the U.S. Supreme Court's decision against cross-district school busing for racial balance in Richmond, Va. will affect the similar case in metropolitan Detroit.

All meetings are in the school board offices at 28830 Eight Mile, Farmington, and are open to the public.

C'ville Band Tries For Third Trophy

Band Director John Nezek and the Clarenceville High School Trojans will be trying

for their third trophy in as many appearances at the July 9-14 National Cherry Festival in Traverse City.

Led by Drum Major Joel Moody, the Trojans will compete in the Cherryland Band Classic, the ninth annual high school band competition to be held during the cherry

fete. In 1967 the Trojans received the first place trophy in Class B, and in 1968 Nezek and his band won the coveted governor's trophy which is awarded to the overall winner in the classic.

The Clarenceville band will also march in the Heritage and Cherry Royale parades and will be eligible for parade band trophies as well as the Toast of Cherryland trophy, awarded each year on the basis of citizenship, audience appeal and participation.

Classes will begin June 18 and run for six weeks in two-week sessions. A student may enroll in one or more classes in each session as well as one or more of the two-week sessions. Classes will meet Monday through Friday for one hour each day. Registration fee is \$8 for each two-week session.

Registration days are Saturday, June 9, and Saturday, June 16, from 9 a.m. until noon at Clarenceville High School.

Among instructors will be Charlie Morse, former state high school champion, Big Ten and national champion, and Mike McCammon, varsity gymnast at Western Michigan University.

Adult Ed Is Course Topic

'Generations' To Be Topic At C'ville

"The Conflict Between Generations" will be the title of the talk by Rabbi David Jessel for baccalaureate at Clarenceville High School on Sunday, June 10, at 8 p.m. in the L.E. Schmidt Auditorium.

Rabbi Jessel, who is associated with the Jewish Community Council of Metropolitan Detroit, and a chaplain with the Livonia police department, is a doctoral candidate in sociology at Wayne State University.

Presently, he is Jewish chaplain at the Detroit House of Correction, serves as rabbinic advisor for teenage groups in the Reform congregations in Michigan and instructs teachers at the College of Jewish studies.
