

## 'Spot Zoning' Stirs Anger

### EDITOR:

This is a word of warning to the residents of Plymouth Township, so they will not have the same problem that arose in our neighborhood.

If you attend a planning commission meeting on rezoning that you are against and the commission has turned it down, this is not the end of it. The board of trustees, our body of elected officials, can override the commission's recommendation and allow the rezoning regardless of how many people are against it. So make sure you know when a rezoning is brought before the trustees and be present to fight your cause.

Over two years ago, a dentist bought a house in our neighborhood (R-1) and requested a rezoning for T-O. It was denied by both the commission and the trustees because it was "spot zoning." A year later the dentist bought the house again, this time the first and last requested rezoning. The commission denied it, but our board of trustees saw fit to grant permission for an ofice. Why the change of heart? They knew 27 signatures of surrounding neighbors were against it. It is

"who you are and not the number that counts?"

In order to fight this zoning, the neighbors should have a referendum against the rezoning put on the ballot of November 1972. You, the people, voted 2 to 1 against the rezoning, but how many of you know that this dentist is being permitted to go in as a non-conforming business?
