'Spot Zoning' Stirs Anger

This is a word of warning to the residents of Plymouth Township, so they will not have the same problem that arose in our neighborhood.

If you attend a planning commission meeting on rezoning that you are against and the commission has turned it down, this is not the end. The board of trustees, our body of elected officials, can override the commission's recommendation and allow the rezoning regardless of how many people are against it. So make sure you know when a rezoning is brought before the trustees and be present to fight your cause.

Over two years ago, a dentist bought a house in our neighborhood (R-1) and requested a rezoning for T-O. It was denied by both the commission and the trustees because it was "spot zoning." A year later the dentist bought the house next door to the first one and requested another rezoning. The commission denied it, but our board of trustees saw fit to grant permission for an office. Why the change of heart? They knew 27 signatures of surrounding neighbors were against it. Is it
