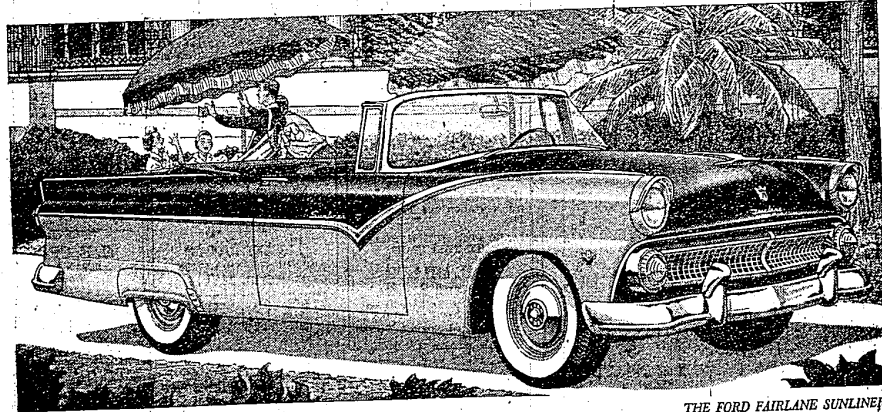
Township Board Adopts Farmington Road Resolution

Farmington Road between Base Line Road, on the south and Grand River Avenue on the north has been improved, and
WHEREAS, subdivisions now being rapidly developed along both sides of Farmington Road, a point one-half mile north of Twelve Mile Road will greatly increase the traffic on said Farmington Road, and
WHEREAS, said Farmington Road, between Ten Mile and Twelve Mile Roads, is now a poorly maintained gravel road, without adequate base and no ditching or culverts for proper drainage, and
WHEREAS, the citizens living in the area serviced by north Farmington Road have made hundreds of telephone calls and have made numerous trips to the road Commissioner's office at Telegraph and Orchard Lake Roads in an effort to maintain the road, but to no avail, and
WHEREAS, during the first two weeks of March the citizens living in the area serviced by north Farmington Road, having been blocked by the deplorable condition of Farmington Road immediately north of Ten Mile Road, were forced to use the roads in Glen Orchard and Farmington Hills subdivisions, thus contributing to heavy breakdowns, then
WHEREAS, during the last two weeks of March the citizens living in the subdivisions between Ten Mile and Twelve Mile Roads were forced to go north on Farmington Road to Twelve Mile Road, thence east on Orchard Lake Road to Grand River Avenue to shop, or transact business in Farmington between March 14th and April 2nd, and
WHEREAS, the curve fronting on the Robertson and Mathews properties, just north of Ten Mile Road, with the high bank along its east side, is dangerous to all traffic, and
WHEREAS, on Wednesday, March 16th, a truck owned by the Oakland County Road Commission was mired over its wheels and axles on Farmington Road just north of Ten Mile Road for more than five hours, thus attesting to the deplorable condition of said road, and
WHEREAS, school buses were not able to traverse Farmington Road at all during the month of March, or when so doing, endangered the lives of the children riding therein, and
WHEREAS, the AAA, other road servicing agencies, and citizens, owning Jeeps and tractors, extricated hundreds of automobiles from mud holes on Farmington Road, and
WHEREAS, the Township of Farmington is considering the erection of a new township office near the intersection of Twelve Mile and Power or Farmington Roads which, if erected in said location, will increase traffic on Farmington Road between the City of Farmington and a new township hall, and
WHEREAS, in addition to the proposed new township office, new elementary and secondary schools and new churches, must and will be erected in the very near future to service the needs of a growing population, which will add traffic to north Farmington Road, and
WHEREAS, Farmington Road is now classified a primary road, thus qualifying for Federal aid, NOW WHEREFORE, the Farmington Township Board requests that the Board of Road Commissioners of Oakland County, Michigan, take immediate steps and necessary action to improve Farmington Road between Ten Mile and Twelve Mile Roads by
1. Reduce the dangerous curve and remove unnecessary high bank along east side of road just north of Ten Mile Road.
2. Build up proper washed stone or limestone base along entire length of Road, as is found necessary to make a first class road.
3. Install culverts at all points necessary to provide proper and adequate drainage from one side to the opposite side of road.
4. Prepare ditches along the entire length of road for proper drainage.
5. Apply asphalt paving, of not less than 4" in thickness on properly prepared base, over the entire length of said Road.
6. Improve intersections of said road with other roads, including installation of adequate culverts under intersecting roads.
7. And perform any other work that may be necessary to converting said portion of Farmington Road into a first class, year-around passable road.
Be it further RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded at once to the Board of Road Commissioners of Oakland County, Michigan and the Highway Commission of the State of Michigan; and that a committee, consisting of not less than three members of the Farmington Township Board, be appointed to meet with the Board of Road Commissioners and representatives of the State Highway Commission immediately for the purpose of reviewing and carrying out the intent of this resolution with Federal aid.
