

# Adults New Emphasis At Community Center

**FARMINGTON**  
An emphasis on adult courses is new this summer for the Farmington Community Center. Class registration is beginning now, and will continue until class maximums are reached.

To fit into summer vacation schedules, two three-week sessions of several classes are offered.

For a full list, or details on time, dates, fees and curriculum, participants are urged to contact the Community Center, located at 10 Mile and Farmington Road.

A sampling of the new classes includes:

- **Tennis:** Three three-week sessions starting June 18. Morning classes are taught by Nancy Johnson and afternoon classes by Gary Bodenmiller. Instruction at North Farmington High, 13 Mile and Farmington Road, is \$18 for nine hours, registered and paid in advance.
- **Golf:** Begins June 13, at the Top of the Tee Golf Range, 14 Mile and Orchard, with golf pro Bob Esler. Ages eight on up learn for fees ranging from \$14 and \$1 for balls, up to \$16 and \$1.50 per bucket for adults.
- **Art Classes:** Ages five on up are taught by instructors Cilla Hill, Bill Harmon, and John Wood. Sculpture and stained glass will also be offered for adults by Karyl and Cilla Hill.
- **Model Airplanes:** Boys 11 and older will be taught by Jerome Brack, "designer of one of the best selling model plane kits in the world."
- **Children:** Other classes include, baton, with chair pian twirler Robyn Rucker story time for tots, and creative dramatics class for early elementary grades by Cecil Orman. Ballet, tap, and guitar are also favorites.
- **Teens and Adults:** Guitar, crafts, crocheting, crew embroidery, macramé, needlepoint, sewing, Japanese cooking, vue d'optique, speed reading, beginning bridge, jazz dancing, yoga and advanced karate are offered.
- **A trip to the Keating-Antique Village, two trips to Stratford, Ontario, band concerts and plays are also coming this summer.**
