to Bel-Aire Hills Subdivision. Following a discussion of this matter, it was agreed that a letter should be sent to Rose-Hill Construction Company, developers of the project, requesting that the debris be removed at once. It was further agreed that unless the request is complied with, steps should be taken to require it.

Following a discussion on the cost of fencing of school property, authorization was granted by the Board for the erection of a fence on the south side of the Gill Road site. An offer was also agreed upon for fencing at the east side of the junior high school site provided that Farmington Lumber Company owners of adjacent property, agree to split the cost of erecting the fence.

A progress report on construction activities of the three new elementary schools in the District was presented to the Board by a representative from the office of the school architect. The report revealed that the laying of tile floors at all three schools should be completed by the end of this week and that furniture is now being moved into rooms already done. Kitchen equipment has not yet arrived but should be here for installation within another week.

At the high school, work on the classroom addition has been finished and both the boys' and girls' locker rooms are being completed now, it was indicated. Due to a delay in obtaining doors, however, it was assumed that the gymnasium proper would not be finished until about two weeks after the start of school.

Plans presented to the Board for grading of the proposed new athletic field at the high school site were studied and minor alterations were suggested.

\$37,075 while A. R. Hatcher submitted the low bid for electrical work with a proposal of \$10,400. The school architect has been authorized to proceed with the completion of the contracts.

Action was also taken by the Board awarding a contract to the Safeway Steel Scaffolds, Inc. for bleachers to accommodate approximately 750 persons at a cost of \$5,061. The bleachers are to be installed at the newly relocated high school athletic field. Final installation date has been set for not later than September 16.

Authorization was given for the feeding of the balance of the athletic field, with the work to be done by the school ground crew.
