

YMCA Is Planning Camps For Kids

Day camp for children three through 12 will be offered by the Northwestern YMCA, 21755 W. Seven Mile, Detroit.

The three through five-year-olds may attend "kiddie camp" at the YMCA on Monday, Wednesday and Friday, from 9 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Gym and pool activities are featured.

The "live Y-camp" is for boys and girls six through eight. They will meet Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Activities are designed to keep active children busy and include roller skating, use of gym equipment, swimming, crafts, movies and a story hour.

Campers seven through 12, years of age also will have the option of attending the regional day camp scheduled Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Campers board the Y bus and ride to Camp Oniesea near Milford for arts and crafts, horseback riding, boating and swimming, archery, nature lore and group games.

For all of the camps, children will be expected to bring sack lunches. The Y will provide the beverage.

There will be three camp sessions, June 25-July 6; July 9-19; July 23-Aug. 2; Aug. 6-16; and Aug. 20-31.

Enrollments are now being taken at the YMCA.
