According to the latest report of the Detroit Metropolitan Area Regional Planning Commission, the City of Farmington is one of the wo fastest growing cities in Oakland County, based on population literes for the period April 1, 1930 to July 1, 1935.

The City of Clawson showed the largest percentage of increase at 98.2 with Farmington second at 84.9%.
