Radioactivity may soon be helping fishermen find where the best
fishing lies.
This summer, a University of
hichigan scientist will be radiolates from "poer" ones.
George H. Lauff, instructor in
zoology, will study bodies of water
ranging in size from small but
lakes from might Huron.
Lauff explains that the productivity of a lake can be measured
by the rate that its microscopic
plants are formed for consumpting
by they consumer's such as juster
fleas. The fleas and other con-

plants are formed for consumpting by tiny consumer's such as twenty fleas. The fleas and other consumers are eaten by small fleas, and the small fish by larger ones, and so on up the aquatic chain. Like a farm, a lake may light the necessary nutrients for the growth of its plants. Lauff loofes, or it may be choked with plants that are not consumed, much as a farm is avergrown with intellible.

In order to determine how well aske plants are doing their job, Lauff, and his associates will periodically sample water at various depths in the lakes. Since earbon in the water is assimilated by the plants in their normal functioning, traces of radioactive or 'tagged' carbon solution added to the samples can be detected in the plants after a short period of time. The amount of radioactive earbon measured will; provide a key to the rate formations of new plant material.
