The work accomplished by the body of four officers of the association was termed great by those at the meeting. Efforts will now be made to convince others in the subdivision of the many and varied benefits and pleasures an association with the aims of this group can have for all.

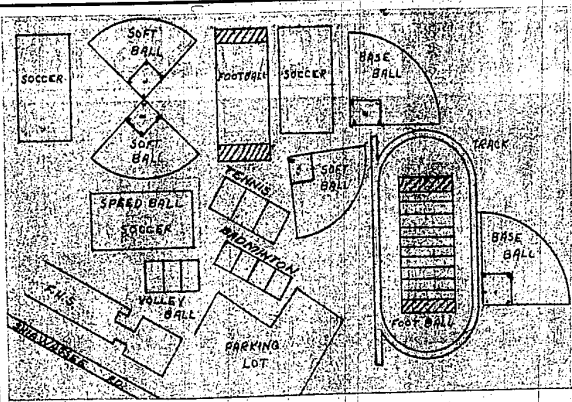
