

New Dean Named By S'craft

Thaddeus E. Diebel, a long-time Michigan educator now serving as an associate professor and dean of the vocational-technical division of Northern Montana College, will return to his home state to serve as the new dean of applied sciences at Schoolcraft College.

Diebel will replace retiring dean Jon Adams, who served the college since 1965. Adams, who saw the technical division grow from 550 to 2,600 students during his tenure, was recently granted emeritus status.

Diebel, who has a bachelor's degree from MSU and earned his master's in vocational education at University of Michigan, has worked in vocational education at several levels. He began his career teaching with the Muskegon schools, where he became assistant director of vocational education. He taught mechanical drafting at Ferris State College for three years before becoming assistant dean of the trade and industrial division there.

He left Michigan in 1965 to become director of vocational education for the state of Montana. In 1966, he headed a party of the U.S. Agency for International Development at the Dunwoody Industrial Institute in Khartoum, Sudan, before the 1967 Middle East war brought about termination of diplomatic relations with that country.

After his stint with USAID, Diebel went to work at Northern Montana College, where he has served since. In addition to his educational experience, the new dean has a total of six years in a diversity of industrial occupations including tool-making, sheet metal stamping and food processing.

Diebel was chosen from among 72 applicants for the position, narrowed to a field of five candidates who were interviewed by a selection committee, faculty screening committee, Vice President for Instructional Affairs Robert Keene and President C. Nelson Grote.
