# OCC Faculty Pay Boost Is 6 Pct.

Faculty salary boosts totaling approximately \$270,000 and fringe benefits adding an estimated additional \$50,000 were approved last week by the board of trustees at Oakland Community College.

The master agreement, covering slightly more than 300 faculty members, was one of four employment contracts settled at the June 14 meeting. Others were for maintenance workers, public safety officers, and various administrative and non-academic supervisory or technical personnel.

## Governor Appoints 3 Residents

LANSING — Three Observer-Herald residents have been appointed to the Radiation Advisory Committee by Governor Milliken.

Those appointed include Walter H. Kohn of W. California Dr., Lathrup Village; Dr. Darlene M. Bennett of Champaign, Southfield; and Frederick W. Wertheimer of Kendallwood Dr., Farmington Township.

The committee's nine members will consider which emergency orders should be issued to protect occupational or public health and safety, issue licenses, registrations and exemptions for radioactive materials, and coordinate radiation control programs of other state departments.

Kohn is a supervisor of field operations for the Industrial Hygiene Department of General Motors Corp.

Dr. Bennett is chief resident physician in the department of radiology of Sinai Hospital. In September, she will be associated with Beaumont Hospital as a fellow in nuclear medicine.

Wertheimer is a professor and chairman of the department of pathology at University of Detroit.
